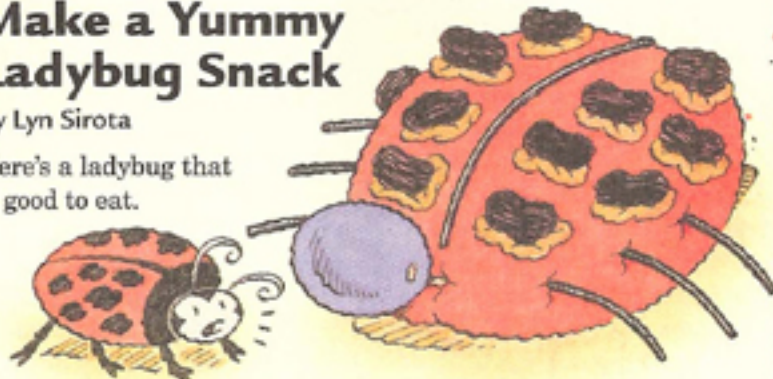

Make a Yummy Ladybug Snack

Here's a ladybug that is good to eat.



1. Wash your hands.
